## Alderman Roche:

Please be advised that the Office of Strategic Planning and Community Development is in receipt of your Board Order #191556, dated June 21, 2011, which requests that the Commissioner of the Department of Public Works install Jersey barriers across Cross Street at Harris Park, and that the Director of OSPCD place child friendly game courts on the enclosed section of street pavement.

Per your request, the Director of the DPW did install the Jersey Barriers, however game courts were not installed, as the sale of the Harris Park property seemed imminent at the time of the request. The Director of Parks and Open Space, Arn Franzen, is happy to review the matter with you as part of the design development process for the New Harris Park to be built at 15-25 Cross Street, and he will review those plans with you during the upcoming Community Meetings process.
