

# 5K RACE

## 5K Turn-by-Turn Directions:

Runners start on Grand Union Blvd just NORTH of the intersection with Artisan Way. Then they run SOUTH towards Boston

Runners continue SOUTH as road becomes Assembly Square Drive, staying on the right side of the road

Runners will do a counterclockwise u-turn before getting to intersection with Mystic Ave. and be running NORTH on Assembly Square Drive

Runners will continue onto Grand Union Blvd

Runners turn RIGHT onto Foley St

Runners turn LEFT onto Great River Rd.

1ST LAP Runners turn LEFT onto Artisan Way

1ST LAP Runners turn LEFT onto Grand Union Blvd and follow previous loop all the way through Great River Rd


2ND LAP Runners turn RIGHT onto Artisan Way (instead of LEFT)

2ND LAP Runners go counterclockwise around loop on other side of T-tracks and return to Artisan Way

2ND LAP Runners turn RIGHT onto Great River Rd.

2ND LAP Runners go counterclockwise around the rotary staying on the outside and then head SOUTH on Grand Union Blvd. and finish at same spot as the start.

Finished runners will be guided down Grand Union Blvd and then LEFT onto Canal Street to go to post-party area.



## ONE MILE RACE

### Mile Race Turn-by-Turn Directions:

Runners start on Grand Union Blvd just south of intersection with Foley Street running southbound (towards Mystic Ave)

Runners continue running onto Assembly Square Drive

Runners turn LEFT onto sidewalk just before intersection with Mystic Ave

Runners make a quick LEFT onto bike path that goes behind Partners building and follows commuter rail tracks heading northbound

Runners turn LEFT off of bike path onto Foley Street

Runners finish before getting back to intersection with Grand Union Blvd
