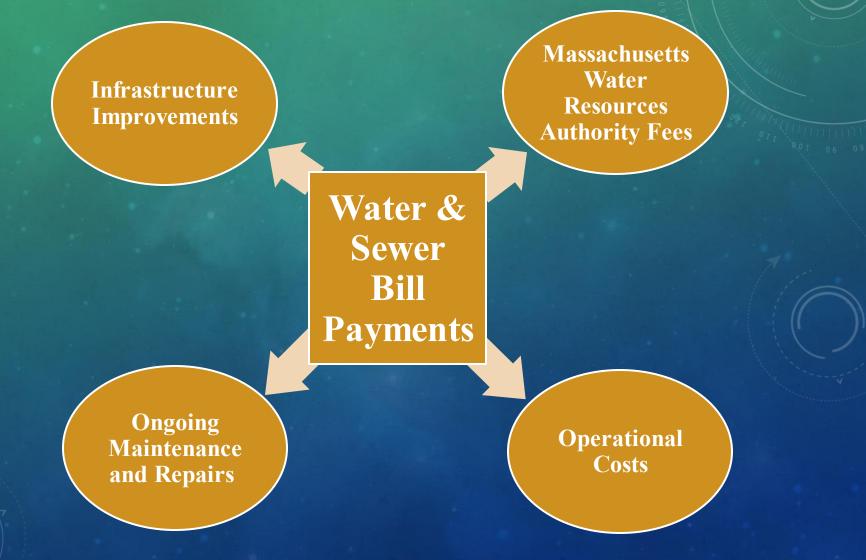

INCREASE IN MWRA FEES \$500M FOR NEEDED INFRASTRUCTURE UPGRADE AND REPLACEMENT





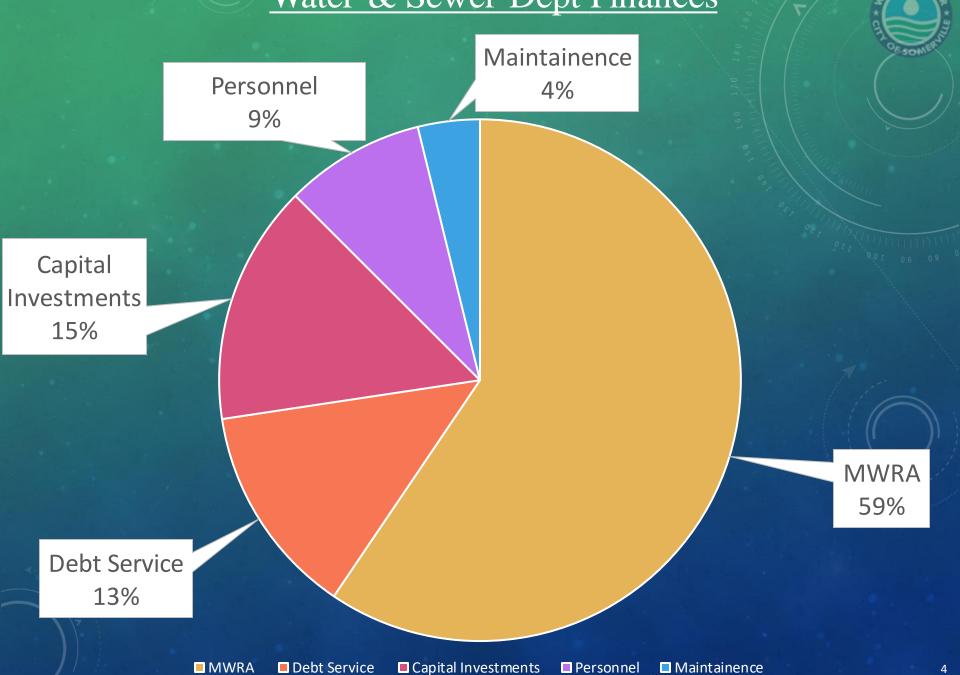
INFLATION AND HIGHER INTEREST RATES

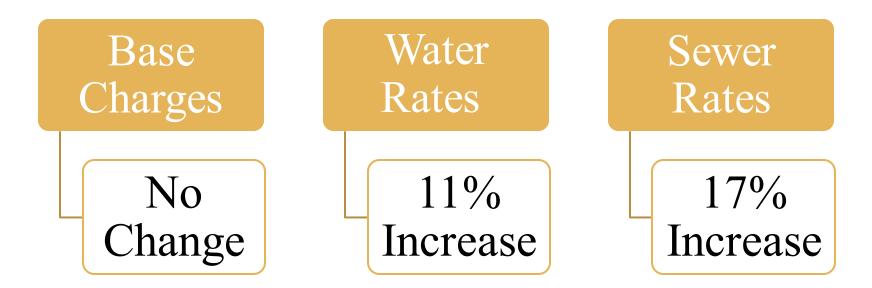


### POPLAR STREET PUMP STATION FINANCING STRATEGY

- Total authorization: \$102M
- Apply \$10M from ARPA (American Rescue Plan Act)
- Utilize \$5M from Sewer Stabilization fund
- Accept up to \$2.5M federal earmark
- Borrow remainder in tranches through bonding
- Bond Authorization of \$89M
- Anticipated budget presented to City Council 11% Water 17% Sewer

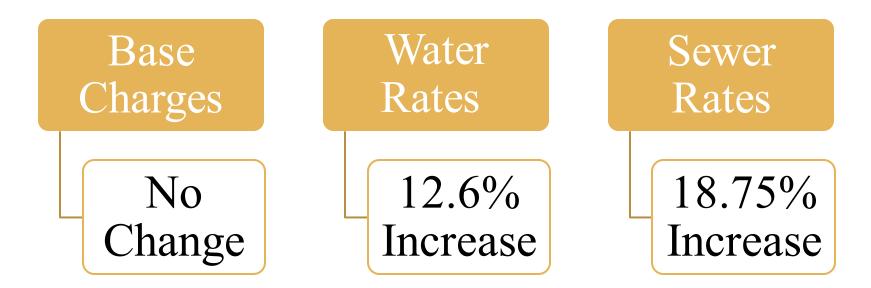
## PROPOSED RATE ADJUSTMENTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024

#### Proposed Nov 2022 to Council



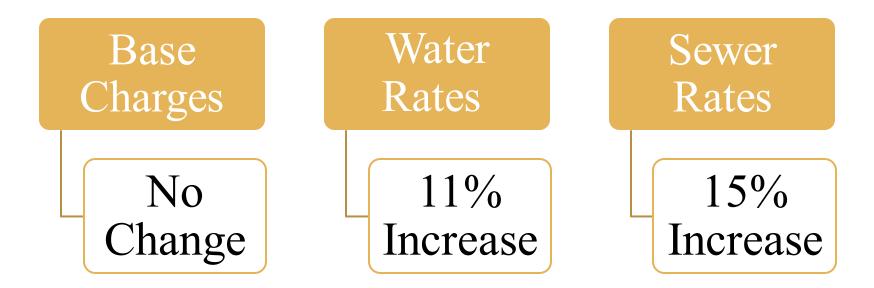
