

Primary Prevention

Bolster Protective Factors and Reduce Risk Factors

- Frequent referrals to the city's Office of Housing Stability
- Weekly multidisciplinary huddle
- Taxi-to-health program (4000+ rides in 2023)
- Mobile farmers markets to improve food access
- Veterans Services supports
- Community Health Workers
- Social Workers providing brief interventions and referrals
- Public Health nurses: home visits, language capacity, free vaccine clinics
- SomerPromise supporting childcare for lowincome families
- Youth Services programs



Secondary Prevention

Early Detection and Referral

- Case management and support; 334 referrals served in 2023!
 - Benefit Assistance
 - Case Management Services
 - Utility Assistance
- Basic needs' supplies
- SNAP



Tertiary Prevention

Supporting People in Crisis

- Supporting Somerville Homeless Coalition Engagement Center
- Backpack program
- Winter warming shelter (16-20/night)
- Mobile shower (future)
- Mobile harm reduction services (1,300 doses of Narcan)
- Public health nursing in various "pop up" sites throughout the city; Spanish for public health nursing
- Opiate Settlement Funds-survey of persons with lived experience

Since Opening the Engagement Center in November 2022, **40 Individuals have been housed**
