Services Inc. for Poplar Street Pump Station Design Services

The Poplar Street Pump Station project is a multi-year design and construction project intended to fundamentally improve the City's capacity to manage stormwater, alleviate flooding, reduce Combined Sewer Overflows, and enable transformative development vital to achieving the goals of SomerVision to increase housing, expand the commercial tax base and create jobs in Somerville. The Administration will soon submit a funding request for the construction phase of the project. Due to the expected duration of the construction project, a time extension to our professional services agreement with Stantec, our engineer of record, will also be required to provide ongoing design and engineering services during construction.
