My name is Ingrid Schneider. I am 42 and have lived in Somerville for over 10 years. I am a single mom to 2 little boys enrolled in Somerville schools.

I was diagnosed with MS 11 years ago. My disease burden was very light until about two years ago. In the past 2 years I have experienced disability. I now walk with a cane, have a handicap placard, do physical therapy and any study available through mgh to try to get stronger. But it's so hard and can be disempowering! It's a complicated journey. I feel like disability has been a new set of glasses and I see the world through a lens of accessibility. (Parking, elevators, handrails), and attitudes of ableism. It's a lot and there's such an emphasis on inclusion but we're still ignored somehow? I would love to be part of a larger conversation and community of people in Somerville (esp. for people my age) who deserve to be seen, considered and have their needs met!
