The Mayor respectfully requests that this Council appropriate \$75,900 from the Energy Stabilization Fund to fund design services for a building project at 42 Cross St. This will include upgrading the roof and roof insulation, LED lighting conversion, updated building controls and a complete decarbonization including high efficiency heat pump HVAC and DHW systems. This request funds the development of construction drawings and project administration during construction. This does not pay for the construction itself. Quotes for that work will be developed as part of the project development outlined here
