It has come to my attention that while the City Council voted on October 24, 2019 (Docket #208518) to approve several traffic fines in excess of \$30.00, there was no adopted ordinance approving the fines, as referenced in the Special Act (Chapter 258 of the Acts of 2002). Therefore, the Law Department recommends that the City Council adopt an ordinance approving the fines, as set forth in the attached ordinance.
