The Mayor respectfully requests that this Council appropriate \$7,110,000 in order to participate in the MWRA Local Water Service Assistance Program (LWSAP) to fund recurring Water Main Rehabilitation projects. The LWSAP program provides interest-free loans to perform water system improvements projects. To meet this appropriation, the Treasurer will be authorized to borrow \$7,110,000 as provided by MGL Chapter 44. Debt service will be paid from the Water Enterprise.
